

## **Scholarship Guidelines**

### **Applicant Eligibility**

Applicant must be a U.S. Citizen or Permanent Legal Resident of the United States.

### **Academic Requirements**

#### **High School Students:**

Applicants must presently have a cumulative high school grade point average of 2.5 or higher on a 4-point scale, have taken either the ACT or SAT test and must be graduating or earning a GED by July 31, 2012 with a verifiable intention to enroll in Fall 2012 at a two or four-year college, trade school or university.

#### **College Students:**

Applicant must have a cumulative college grade point average of 2.5 or higher on a 4-point scale, and be currently enrolled at an accredited two or four-year college, trade school or university.

### **Description and Distribution of Scholarship**

The reward for your efforts is a one-time \$500 scholarship, which may be applied to qualified expenses, including tuition, fees, books, and on-campus room and board. Funds are provided by The Law Office of Joshua Pond and payments are issued by The Law Office of Joshua Pond. The reward will be mailed after March 15th, 2012 directly to your accredited college, trade school or university.

### **Winning Essay Selection:**

Our judges will select the winner after the deadline of Feb 29th, 2012.

Applicants are judged on creativity, thoughtfulness, and insight, as well as how well they promoted their particular position. The winner will be announced March 15th, 2012.

### **Conditions of Award**

If the applicant is employed by The Law Office of Joshua Pond at the time of award, the scholarship is void.

The school to which the applicant seeks this scholarship to be applied must be accredited.

The recipient must be actively enrolled full-time as student in fall 2012 and for the entire academic year without interruption, barring illness, emergency, or military service. It is the recipient's responsibility to verify receipt of funds with their designated institution and to notify The Law Office of Joshua Pond should the funds not arrive within 30 days of the issue date.
